Please work as a family to complete as many of these tasks as you can. For the 'Brain Wave' section, you may like to think of your own research or project that you could complete linked to the Learning Adventure.

How has our high street changed?	Research when the Simmons on the high street was built. How many years ago was that? Can you find the difference? CHALLENGE! Can you create a number sentence showing the difference between the two amounts?	Pretend you work for the council, create a brochure for tourists explaining and describing how our high street has changed. CHALLENGE! Remember to include the correct punctuation and prepositions as well as some conjunctions and adjectives.	Where are your parents and grandparents from? Discuss what is different and what is the same as London Colney high street and where they are from LC, get them to share with you which places/ shops they enjoyed on the high street when they were younger. CHALLENGE! Visit one of these places and have your adult tell you what's stayed the same and what has changed!	Create a drawing of the high street or your favourite place on the high street! CHALLENGE! Can you find and draw what was once there 50 years ago? What's the same? Different?	Teach/tell your grownups all about the memories you have of school from reception to year 3 and what you've noticed that's changed. CHALLENGE! Can you role play your most memorable moments?	Visit another high street (even better if it's one you've never been to!) CHALLENGE! Can you find a shop or building you wish that London Colney high street had?	What is the same and what is different between LC high street and the high street you have visited most recently? CHALLENGE! Create a Venn diagram showing the similarities and differences	Use google earth to explore and look at other high streets in Hertfordshire and compare them to London Colney's. CHALLENGE! Can you find and name at least 3 other high streets?
