Communication, Language and Understanding

- To encourage children to listen with interest to stories and rhymes.
- Encourage children to use questions e.g. how , what ,where in conversations.



Personal, Emotional and Social development

- Continue to support children to be independent in choosing resources.
- To develop wider friendships.
- Encourage children to respond positively to the feelings and wishes of others.



Expressive Arts and Design

- Encouraged to join in singing favourite theme related songs and rhymes.
- Children will experiment with textures, materials and textiles.
- To explore experiences using different media

Understanding of the World

- During pretend play, opportunities to imitate actions and events from family and culture.
- Opportunities will be given to play with small world activities linked to theme.
- Technological toys will be available for the children to show an interest and develop


Literacy

- Encouraged to join in with rhymes and stories linked to themes.
- Continue to give opportunities for children to look at books independently.
- Opportunities to begin to distinguish different marks they make will be provided.



Mathematics

- Opportunities will be given in activities to compare quantities.
- Begin to show an interest in numbers in the environment.
- Continue to encourage children to use some number names and number language spontaneously.
- To continue to categorise objects according to properties such as shape or size .
