English

Within our English lessons, we will be focusing on the text

The Emperor's Egg. We will continue to complete Big Write each week and learn new grammar devices which will be outlined in Talk Homework weekly.



Learning Adventure

This enquiry introduces young geographers to the concept of biomes and natural regions. It enables them to understand the importance of location in relation to the Equator and poles in determining weather and climate, which in turn have such an influence on shaping the natural geographical features of environments. Pupils will come to understand the distribution of hot and cold places in the world and how living things have to adapt to survive in such places.

Computing

We will be using Purple Mash to learn about Spreadsheets.



Maths

In maths this half term, we will be focusing on addition and subtraction.



Science

In our science work we will be exploring the topic 'Animals Including Humans' Children will explore how animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults. Children will investigate the basic needs of animals in order to survive and will think about how keeping healthy contributes to this.



Religious Education

Religion—Christianity. We will be investigating the question 'Why do Christians believe that God gave Jesus to the world?'
