We are very happy to announce that Oscar & Nyla S, have been elected as Head Boy & Head Girl.



What is Weather?

In topic this half term, our focus is Geography: Antarctica. We have been learning about weather and comparing weather in the UK to Antarctica. We know that weather and climate is determined by lines of latitude and how close or far away a place is from the North and South Pole and the Equator.

We defined weather as being what the sky and air is like in a place. We then made weather dials to represent some different types of weather...

➤ Did you know that all children should have a dental check-up at least yearly? Children should start going to see a dentist as soon as their milk teeth appear. NHS dental care for children is free.



Also, all children should have a regular eye check at a high street optician. The routine eye test will check if your child needs glasses and is also an important check for overall eye health. Opticians appointments are free for children and some glasses are free or subsidised by the NHS.
