



London Colney Primary and Nursery School – Covid-19 Non-Negotiable Home School Agreement

The following document has been devised to outline the expectations in place for pupils, parents and school and these expectations will be adhered to strictly whilst government measures are in place. Parents will need to return a signed copy of this to school with their child before a pupil may return to school.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All staff will be welcoming and supportive of the children when returning. Sufficient time will be timetabled daily to allow children the opportunity to talk about their experiences of lockdown. • All staff will ensure that the children are cared for and nurture whilst sticking to the social distancing measures. • All pupils will have access to their own equipment to use during the school day. • All classrooms and resources exposed to staff or pupils will be cleaned daily and deep cleaned weekly. • Teachers will, where possible, endeavour to continue to set and respond to home learning for children who still require. • Staff will ensure that timetables, including drop off and pick up times, are staggered to ensure there are as few people near site as possible at any given time. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children will not bring any equipment, toys or technology onto site. • Children will be respectful and appropriate to all staff onsite and follow the usual school rules. • Children will be respectful to their friends and peers, understanding that everyone's experiences have been different and that this will need to be discussed appropriately. • Children will follow the school's new rules on social distancing and will try their hardest not to have physical contact with their peers or teachers. • Children will move around the school sensibly and calmly at all times, following the school's new one-way system. • Children will not share resources or food during the school day. • Children will try their hardest to ensure they are maintaining social distancing when completing outdoor play. • Children will fully understand that if they are unable to follow the school's new rules and measures they will need to continue to complete home learning from home • Children not sticking to the NO TOUCHING rules will be sent home • Children are not allowed to cough or spit at anyone. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents and Carers will speak to their child before returning to school, ensuring they understand the new rules and measures in place at school. • Ensure social distance from other adults whilst waiting for gates to open – as per government guidance (please do not arrive too early to avoid congregation) • Parents and Carers will remain respectful and polite to all school staff at all times, understanding why these new measures have been put in place. • Parents to adhere to allocated drop off/pick up times and place • Parents and carers will ensure that their child does not come to school with any belongings from home. • A primary parent or carer will be available via telephone at ALL times throughout the school day. • A primary parent or carer will be available at ALL times throughout the day to come ASAP and collect their child should they become ill or displaying symptoms of COVID-19 • A primary parent or carer will be available at ALL times throughout the day to come and collect their child ASAP from school should their child be unable to follow the new school rules. • Parents and Carers understand that their child will need to continue learning from home if the school deems appropriate.



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		<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Parents and carers will flexible, understanding that circumstances at school may change quickly.• Pre-school children to stay with Parent/Carer at all times (e.g. buggy, holding hands, reigns)
