History Focus: The Vikings Children will learn about the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor. Children will explore and investigate Viking raids and invasion, resistance by Alfred the Great and others, Anglo-Saxon law and justice and Edward's death.	Geography Focus: Rainforests Children to explore and investigate the rainforests of the world. Children to learn about the layers of a rainforests and the animals and plants that may reside in the rainforest. Children to learn about current world issues such as de-forestation and how rainforests are affected now.	History Focus: Anglo-Saxons and the Scots Children will learn about Britain's settlements by the Anglo-Saxon and Scots. Children to explore the Roman removal from Britain, the Scots invasion from Ireland to Scotland, Anglo-Saxon invasions, settlements and kingdoms and Anglo-Saxon art and culture.	Geography Focus: Build A Village Children will learn about different types of settlements. Explore services in our local area. Children will investigate village life in our host and home country and how to map and record geographical information.	History Focus: The Mayans Children to learn about a non-European society that provides contrast with British history through the context of the Mayans. Children to explore culture, art, religion and societies.	Geography Focus: St Lucia – A comparison to the UK Children to learn about the island of St Lucia. Children to explore the physical and human geography of the island, considering culture, climate and leisure. Children to make comparisons to holiday destinations in the UK.
Science Focus: Animals Including Humans Children to describe the changes as humans develop to old age. Properties and Changes of Materials (1) Children to compare and group materials based on an increasingly more complex criteria compared to previous years. Children to know that some materials dissolve and use their knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to consider how mixtures might be separated.	Science Focus: Living Things and Their Habitats Children to describe the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird. Children to describe the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals.	Science Focus: Forces Children to explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object. Children to identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction that act between moving surfaces.	Science Focus: Electricity (Year 4) Children identify and name common appliances that run on electricity. Construct a simple series circuit, naming its basic parts. Identify whether a lamp will light up or not and associate this with a switch opening and closing. Recognise some common conductors and insulators.	Science Focus: Earth and Space Children to describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system. Children to describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth and describe the Sun, Earth and Moon as approximately spherical bodies. Children to use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky. Art Focus: Viking Dragons Children will explore Viking designs which include knots and animals. Children to accurately sketch a Viking dragon head. We will explore patterns and shapes, areas of light and shade and how we can use sketching to achieve this.	DT Focus: Food and Nutrition – Biscuits Children will explore different kinds of biscuits, including their flavours, textures and appearances, find out which biscuits are most and least popular, as well as design, make evaluate and eat their own biscuits. When adding flavours children will take into consideration the seasonal availability of ingredients.	Art Focus: Anglo-Saxon Brooch Children will explore Anglo-Saxon art which includes brooches, belt buckles, tapestry and carving. Children will design their own brooch, and recreate these in 3D form using clay and sculpting techniques.	DT Focus: Structures – Building Bridges Children will explore different types of bridges and the structures that support them. Children will explore the way in which forces act upon bridge structures, how they are constructed and strengthened. They will design, make and evaluate a variety of bridge designs.	Art Focus: Peter Thorpe Space Rocket Children will learn about the artist and style of Peter Thorpe, and use mixed media to create their own Rocket Art in the style of the artist. Artist Week – LS Lowry / Vincent Van Gough	DT Focus: Food and Nutrition with a focus on Caribbean food. – Serve a Salad Children will learn about different types of salads and the ingredients from different places around the world. They will learn about healthy eating (with a focus on fibre) and practise using food preparation skills. They will design and make a Caribbean salad for lunch.
